

JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2023 ENTRY



1. Pupils who are awarded scholarships will enter the school the following September into the first year (D Year). Scholarships are tenable throughout a scholar's career at Bryanston, subject to satisfactory progress, commitment to their area of scholarship, as well as continuing to show the enthusiasm, commitment and leadership qualities expected of all Bryanston scholars.
2. On receipt of a completed application form, the candidate will be invited to attend the relevant scholarship day. Application forms received after the closing date may not be considered.
3. Scholarship candidates are required to attend the scholarship day(s) at Bryanston.
4. Successful candidates must perform well in their sphere(s) of excellence, pass tests set by the school, perform well in interviews and be supported by a satisfactory report from their previous school.
5. Awards carry a maximum discretionary award of up to 10% remission of the fees, irrespective of the number of scholarships awarded. This remission may be enhanced by a bursary if parents were to show, through a means-testing process, that they would not otherwise be able to send their child to Bryanston. A Statement of Financial Circumstances form must be returned to the Bursar ASAP and by 16 December 2022 at the very latest.
6. Families of a child being awarded a scholarship who may not be in need of financial support are invited to consider their child becoming an Honorary Scholar, with the same status and responsibilities of all other scholars. Their remission can then be passed to another pupil whose financial need is fully shown.
7. All scholarship candidates must be registered and have paid the £200 registration fee. In the event of a candidate not being awarded a scholarship, a place at the school cannot be guaranteed unless there is a place available on the Main Entry List and the acceptance deposit of £1,000 and confirmation deposit of £1000 have been paid.
8. Scholarship offers are made at the discretion of the Head and his decision is final.
9. In order to qualify for a place at Bryanston, all Scholarship and Award winners must pass the Common Academic Scholarship Exams, Common Entrance Exams or the School's Entrance Exams, with the exception of pupils who gain either an Academic Scholarship or an Academic Award.
10. An offer of a place is accepted by completing the Acceptance Form and payment of the confirmation and acceptance deposits.
11. All scholars will have a personal mentor in their scholarship field. Their mentor will guide and encourage them, as well as monitor their progress throughout their Bryanston career.
12. The admission of a pupil is conditional on acceptance of the school's standard Terms and Conditions, a copy of which is available on request.
