## GIFT AID DECLARATION (UK taxpayers only)

I understand that Bryanston School will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I donate. Bryanston School can reclaim the basic rate of tax from H.M. Customs and Revenue. Higher rate taxpayers can reclaim the difference between the basic rate of tax (20%) and the highest rate of tax they have paid (40% or 45%) after making a charitable donation. Higher rate taxpayers must include all their Gift Aid donations on their Self-Assessment tax return to receive their tax relief. Below is an indication of how much Bryanston would receive and how much it would cost you as a higher rate taxpayer.

- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Charities Aid Foundation or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you
