Higher rate taxpayers must include all their Gift Aid donations on their Self-Assessment tax return to receive their tax relief. - If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Charities Aid Foundation or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Charities Aid Foundation asks you to.
