Clothing/Packing Lists for Pupils in B, C and D

All clothes must be clean, tidy and in good repair and must be clearly marked. In addition, they must be machine washable and suitable for tumble-drying. A charge will be made to cover the cost of marking any article, which is found to be unmarked.

The following is a list of the minimum requirements. **The school reserves the right to buy any essential article of clothing missing from the list for a pupil and to charge to the parents' bill.**

School dress clothing can be purchased from the School Shop but all Games kit **must** be purchased from the School Shop. The school shop offers a complete personal service for new and existing pupils via an appointment only service in the summer holidays. The shop opening times are Monday – Friday 09.00 – 16.00. Appointments are essential and take approximately 1 hour, it is advisable to pre book early as the shop gets very busy during peak times. Please note that full payment for uniform purchases will be required at the time of purchase, payment can be made with cash, credit card or cheque, payable to Bryanston Conference Centre Ltd. Items marked with * are regulation school items and are available from the School Shop only.

SCHOOL DRESS

Minimum (as required)

- 5 plain polo shirts with sleeves, of appropriate length.
- 3 plain full length trousers; no denim, corduroy, leather, satin or velvet.
(for boys: must be black or navy with a permanent crease or classic cut chino; not skinny.)
(for girls: must be black with black stitching with zip or button fly; not faded; not combat style)
or
- 3 plain skirts.
(must be black or navy blue avoiding extremes of length; no denim, corduroy, leather, velvet or bodycon.)
- 3 plain jumpers or sweatshirts.
(must be V neck or round neck; not roll neck, not faded; no hoods, motifs, zips or pockets.)
- 7 pairs of pants.
- 7 pairs of plain socks or black opaque tights.
- 5 bras.
- 2 pairs of leather shoes (max heel height 4cm).
(must be black or dark brown; monocoloured; not above the ankle; not backless or trainer style.)

CONCERT DRESS

- 1 black dress with sleeves or black suit with white shirt and sober tie.
or
- 1 black shirt or blouse with school regulation trousers or skirt.

OTHER ESSENTIAL ITEMS

- 3 pairs of pyjamas or equivalent.

- 3 bath towels (with loops and name tape on corner).
- toiletries and sponge bag.
- 1 duvet (clearly marked on corner).
- 2 duvet covers (clearly marked on the outside of the opening).
- 2 pillow cases (clearly marked).
- 1 weekend case or bag.
- 3 *mesh laundry bags that must be purchased from the School Shop.
- 1 lockable tuckbox.

OTHER OPTIONAL ITEMS

- 1 weatherproof coat or jacket (not denim, suede or leather).
- 1 dressing gown.
- 1 pair slippers.
- 1 cycling helmet (compulsory for cyclists).

AFTER SCHOOL CLOTHES

A selection of casual clothes that pupils can wear in their free time. Specific additional guidance on after school clothes will be provided to pupils at various points during the year in relation to what is appropriate.

SPORTS KIT

Consideration should be given to the sports your child will be playing each term in the current academic year. *(In the Autumn term of D, all girls play hockey and all boys play rugby.)*

***Denotes regulation item that must be purchased from the School Shop.**

Minimum (as required)

- 1 *sports bag.
- 1 *hoodie.
- 1 *pair tracksuit bottoms.
- 1 *navy PE/games skort **or** *white PE/hockey shorts.
- 2 *white polo shirts.
- 2 *pairs games socks.
- 2 *pairs short white sports socks.
- 1 baselayer.
- 1 plain, one colour swimming trunks or one piece costume.
- 1 swimming hat.
- 2 pairs trainers (1 for outdoor use, 1 with non-marking soles for indoor use).
- 1 *sports and Adventure Training jacket or gilet.

Additional compulsory items for hockey:

- 2 *navy hockey shirts for girls. (Boys wear their navy rugby shirts.)
- 1 mouthguard (we recommend a professionally fitted mouthguard).
- 1 pair shin pads.
- 1 hockey stick.
- 1 pair astro shoes.

Additional compulsory items for rugby:

- 1 *hooped rugby shirt.
- 1 *navy rugby shirt.
- 2 *pairs navy rugby shorts.
- 1 mouthguard (we recommend a professionally fitted mouthguard).
- 1 pair rugby boots.

Additional compulsory items for netball:

- 1 *netball shirt.

Additional compulsory items for tennis or squash:

- 1 *white games skort for girls. (Boys wear their white PE shorts.)
- 1 tennis or squash racket.

Additional compulsory items for cross country or athletics:

- 1 *athletics vest.

1 pair spikes.

Additional compulsory items for cricket:

1 *cricket shirt.

1 *cricket jumper.

1 *pair of cricket trousers.

1 pair of cricket boots.

Additional compulsory items for rowers:

*specialised kit for C and above as directed by the Head of Rowing.
