Arrangements for the start of term

Sunday 8 September

- During the summer holidays you will receive a letter from your child's Housemaster/Housemistress, telling you what time to arrive at your child's House on afternoon of Sunday 8 September.
- Please ensure your child arrives in school dress.
- You and your child will meet the Housemaster/Housemistress, along with other staff on the House Team.
- Your child will be shown to their dorm, where they can unpack.
- At approximately 3.45pm your child will say goodbye to you and will stay in their House to chat to the other new D pupils. You will go to the Music School for an address by the Head and then to the Main School for tea and to meet your child's Tutor. You will then be free to leave.
- At approximately 5.15pm your child will be taken to the Main building to meet their Tutor, who will give them their timetable and show them where their lessons will take place the next morning. Your child will then collect books and stationery and their Tutor will help them find their way back to their House.
- Housemasters/Housemistresses will take your child to supper at approximately 7.00pm, when the Catering Manager will explain how the Dining Hall works.
- After supper your child will meet the Chaplain and the Director of Music in the Music School before returning to their House.
