## Clothing/Packing Lists for Pupils in B, C and D

**All clothes must be clean, tidy and in good repair and must be clearly marked.** In addition, they must be machine washable and suitable for tumble drying. A charge will be made to cover the cost of marking any article, which is found to be unmarked.

Plain polo shirts with sleeves, of appropriate length	5
Plain full-length trousers; no denim, corduroy, leather, satin, or velvet <b>For Boys:</b> must be black or navy with a permanent crease or classic cut chino; not skinny <b>For Girls:</b> must be black with black stitching with zip or button fly; not faded; not combat style	3

Plain skirts Must be black or navy blue avoiding extremes of length; no denim, corduroy, leather, velvet or bodycon	3
Plain jumpers or sweatshirts Must be v-neck or round neck; not roll neck, not faded; no hoods, motifs, zips, or pockets	3

Pairs of leather shoes (max heel height 4cm) Must be black or dark brown; monocoloured; not above the ankle; not backless or trainer style	2
