Prior to the day

Covid protocols: we would like to request that parents attending Activities Day complete a Lateral Flow Test on the morning of the event where possible.

If your child displays any symptoms of Covid on the morning of the event, please do not attend, but advise us of this by emailing: activitiesday@bryanston.co.uk so that we can update Group Supervisors accordingly.

We will be ensuring that the School's Covid protocols are followed throughout the event.

Dress:

- **General:** It would be a great help if children could arrive ready for their activities (tracksuits/shorts and trainers are ideal).
- **Kayaking:** A change of clothes is essential for kayaking. They may also wish to bring swimwear and a towel. Please note that, for safety reasons, children will not be allowed on the river in jeans or thick trousers.
- **Climbing/bouldering:** Children should wear long trousers, long hair should be tied back and no jewellery should be worn.
- **Swimming:** Please bring swimwear and a towel.
- **Art:** These sessions may get a bit messy, so it would be a good idea for your child to pack an apron (if they have one).

Equipment:

- **Photography:** For those pupils signed up to do photography, if they have their own mobile phone, then it would be helpful for them to bring it along on the day (simply to take photos with), but this is not essential.

Non-swimmers may not take part in kayaking or swimming.

Church: Please note that contrary to previous communications, parents will not be able to join our church service on the morning of the event due to Covid restrictions.

On the day

Parking: Please use the Coade Hall car park.

Collection: Please collect your child from the Concert Hall (in the Tom Wheare Music School) at 5.00pm after the final registration of the day has taken place. You are kindly asked not to depart until your child has been re-registered.

Wet weather plans: We will be keeping a close eye on the weather forecast for the 19th, but if it looks likely to rain, we recommend that your child brings a waterproof coat on the day, as there will be a lot of walking to and from activities across the campus. We would expect most activities to run as planned, but should any activities be cancelled due to adverse weather, we will arrange a suitable indoor alternative.

In the event of wet weather, we will hold the talk with the Headmaster in Coade Hall.
