Your Senior School fees explained 2025/26

Please note all costs are quoted inclusive of VAT

Registration Fee

To register your child at Bryanston there is a non-refundable fee of £300.00 for Year 9 to 12.

Acceptance Deposit

After a successful application, an Acceptance Deposit is required with the completed and signed Acceptance Form. If the pupil is withdrawn or the accepted place is not taken up, the deposit is non-refundable.

Parents resident in the UK are required to pay a £2,200 deposit. £1000 is credited toward the pupil's first term fees, and the remaining £1,200 is applied to the final leaver's bill (at the end of the final Summer Term).

Parents not resident in the UK are required to pay a One Term Fee Deposit in addition to the £2,200 Acceptance Deposit. This is refunded to the final Summer Term Fee Bill.

School Fees 2025/26 – Senior School

The fees are payable 7 days before the start of the term by direct debit or bank transfer. Fee bills are published on the Parent Portal and an email will be sent from the Chief Finance and Operations Officer, or a member of her team, when they are available to view. The planned dates are as below: -

Autumn Term 2025 - published no later than 14 August 2025 - due for payment by 25 August 2025

Spring Term 2026 – published no later than 22 December 2025 – due for payment 29 December 2025

Summer Term 2026 – published no later than 7 April 2026 – due for payment 13 April 2026

The Boarding fees for 2025/26, cover tuition costs for the standard curriculum, the facilities, travel for most sports and games, personal accident insurance, meals, accommodation and laundry.

As noted below there is a charge for Day with Bed pupils who wish to stay overnight.

Please note that breakfast and evening meals are not available for Day Only pupils.

The fees will be reviewed by the Governors during your child's education and may increase in accordance with our terms and conditions which are available on our website.

Fee notes

Day with bed pupils at Bryanston are fully integrated into boarding life. Our unique approach means our pupils are part of a boarding house and even have their own bed should they decide to flexi-board or transition to becoming a full-boarder. Day with bed pupils are, of course, welcome to stay overnight, we just ask for clear communication with the pupil's House Parent and there is an additional charge of £71.10 per night.

Day pupils arrive at 8.15am and leave at 6pm (the day service bus leaves at 6.30pm, when the school day finishes). Day only pupils will join a boarding house and are included in every aspect of the daily life of the School with their peers.

Fees in advance

We offer all parents a Fees in Advance Scheme, which offers discounts for making lump sum fee payments in advance. Please contact finance@bryanston.co.uk if you would like to discuss this further.

Please ensure that any bank charges are considered when arranging payment so that Bryanston receives the full amount due. Notification of changes to bank account details will only be communicated by the School's Chief Finance and Operations Officer.

Late Payment of Fees

If you pay late, we will charge late payment fees as follows:

- £40 per invoice for non-payment between 7-14 days;
- A further £40 for non-payment between 15-28 days;

If any amount is outstanding, after a 28-day period, the accounts will attract interest on the overdue amount at 8% above bank base-rate, and as set out in our parent contract.

Overseas Pupils

All pupils that required a Child Student Visa Payment will be charged a compliance fee of £600.00.

Other Charges

Extras fall into three broad categories; educational, recreational, and personal which are listed below.

Educational Charges

iPads

As part of the School's digital strategy all pupils are issued an iPad, with Keyboard, cover and stylus. All parents will be expected to complete the School's Parent iPad agreement and a charge of £100.00 per term, will appear on the pupil's bill, this charge also includes Apple care insurance, please note that this cover does not include any protection against loss or non-accidental damage.

School Trips

There will be opportunities to attend extra-curricular trips either within the UK or abroad. These will be at an extra cost.

Music Tuition

Individual music tuition is charged termly in arrears - £379.00 per term per instrument (for up to 30 lessons per year). Music students also bear the cost of sheet music purchased for their own use. Notice period of half a term is required, particularly if you choose not to continue with music tuition at the end of Year D. Please check the terms and conditions on the music booking form. Instrument hire is available for an additional charge.

Textbooks

At Bryanston, pupils purchase their own textbooks and stationery. If textbooks are no longer needed for study, they may be returned to the Shop. The School may buy back these returned books at their second-hand value (up to 50% of the original price) if they are unmarked, have undamaged covers and remain appropriate to the curriculum.

At the end of a pupil's first term, you will see charges from the School Shop which help with the efficient running of the School. For instance, 4 laundry bags, name tapes for Matrons to label unnamed items that arrive from home, pen, calculator, pad of paper and geometry set.

Individual Tuition

Where a need has been identified and agreed with parents, individual tuition will be charged as an extra. One-to-one lessons are charged in arrears at £54.00 for a 30-minute lesson in the following areas: English as an Additional Language (EAL), Maths Support and Learning Support. A reduced rate is offered for lessons with 2 pupils or more.

External Examinations Fees

These are an additional charge. In certain circumstances special arrangements made for examinations are chargeable.

Materials used in Art, Sculpture, Pottery, and Design and Technology are charged in arrears termly.

Recreational Extras

Pupils can join various groups, clubs, and societies. Membership fees vary based on the activity's complexity and cost. Additionally, weekend trips, activities, and events may incur charges.

Rowing – D Rowers £72.00, C Rowers £96.00, Senior Rowers (B, A3, A2) £120.00 per term. British Rowing Racing Licence is an additional fee of £40, if required.

Kayaking - £57.00, termly.

Sailing – Currently £36.00, Summer 2026 prices to be confirmed in Spring 2026. Lessons to be booked directly with Spinnaker Sailing.

Squash - £25.80, per session when chosen as a sport.

Tennis - Private tuition can be arranged and charged in addition.

Dance – currently £7.80 per session, 2025/26 price TBC.

Speech and Drama - £379.00.

Duke of Edinburgh - registration fees and expedition costs.

Equestrian - horse riding lessons are £500.00 for 10 lessons on average per term. Livery fees, including holiday period, are £270.00 per horse, per week.

Personal expenditure

Pupils and parents may incur additional charges for personal expenses. These include items from the School Shop (sports kit, equipment, and stationery), transport fees (for exeat and term start/end), theatre tickets, house parties, school photographs, dry cleaning, damage charges, private medical treatment, and transport for hospital visits.

Additional charges you will also find the membership fees of the Bryanston Parents' Association and [Beyond Bryanston](#) (the Alumni Association) both of which can be opted out from. To learn more please follow the links.

The campus is cashless, so pupils need a debit card, pre-paid card, or electronic payment method like Apple Pay.

Insurance

Endsleigh Pupils' £600k Personal Accident Insurance - included within the School fee is personal accident cover; pupils are automatically insured. Details will be sent out separately.

Endsleigh Pupils' Personal Effects Insurance

The School regrets that it is unable to accept responsibility for loss, damage, or theft of pupils' belongings. Parents can cover their child's property on an "All Risks" basis for up to £2,000 for a single item and £5,000 total sum insured. Your child will not be included in the scheme unless you elect to opt-in. Details will be sent out separately.

Endsleigh Pupil Absence Insurance

Fees and any agreed supplemental charges will not normally be reduced or refunded because of absence due to illness or otherwise.

Parents may be able to receive a refund of fees if their child is absent from School by paying an additional sum each term. Your child will not be included in the scheme unless you elect to opt-in. Notice Period

Please refer to the terms and conditions for more information but parents are reminded that a full term's notice is required when withdrawing a pupil. This should be made in writing to the Head's office. For example, to give notice for September 2026 the Headmaster needs to receive notice before the start of the Summer 2026 Term 20 April 2026.

VAT

HMRC introduced VAT from the 1st January 2025 on various educational supplies. The school will apply VAT where required and at the rates determined by HMRC. We will endeavour to show whether fees are inclusive or plus VAT, but the school must always charge within the HMRC statutory guidance and therefore rates may vary.
