

Your Prep School fees explained 2025/26

Please note all costs are quoted inclusive of VAT, except for Nursery Fees.

Registration Fee

To register your child at Bryanston Prep there is a non-refundable fee of £120.00 for Nursery through to Year 8.

Acceptance Deposit

After a successful application, an acceptance deposit is required and the completed and signed Acceptance Form. If the pupil is withdrawn or the accepted place is not taken up, the deposit is non-refundable.

Parents resident in the UK are required to pay a £420 deposit. This is applied to the final leaver's bill. Parents who are not resident in the UK are required to pay a One Term Fee Deposit in addition to the £420 acceptance deposit.

The balance of the deposit is refundable after the deduction of any outstanding charges following your final invoice. If at the end of Year 8, you plan for your child to attend the senior school, then these funds are retained, and you will be asked to make a top up payment to cover the deposit required at the senior school.

School Fees 2025/26

Fees are payable 7 days before the start of each term by direct debit or bank transfer. Fee bills are published on the Parent Portal and an email will be sent from the Chief Finance and Operations Officer, or a member of her team, when they are available to view. The planned dates are as below: -

Autumn Term 2025 - published no later than 14 August 2025 - due for payment by 25 August 2025

Spring Term 2026 – published no later than 22 December 2025 – due for payment 29 December 2025

Summer Term 2026 – published no later than 7 April 2026 – due for payment 13 April 2026

The international boarding fee is charged for all international pupils. It also applies to British pupils living overseas where one or both parents, living overseas, are responsible for paying the fees.

The Nursery Fees

Nursery fees will remain exempt from VAT.

Please note that up to 15 hours per week of early-year funding vouchers are available for eligible children. Early years funding begins the term following the child's third birthday and continues until the term in which they are five.

Scholarships

Pupils are welcome to apply for Scholarships enrolled in Year 2, Year 4 or Year 6, applying for places in Year 3, Year 5 and Year 7. The scholarship window for September 2026 will be advertised on the school website.

Bursaries

Bursaries are awarded from Year 3 to pupils in the Prep School, whose parents demonstrate financial need. All awards are made through a means tested application, at the absolute discretion of the school, as school funds allow and are reviewed annually.

Please ensure that any bank charges are considered when arranging payment so that Bryanston receives the full amount due. Notification of changes to bank account details will only be communicated by the School's Chief Finance and Operations Officer.

Late Payment of Fees

If you pay late, we will charge late payment fees as follows:

£40 per invoice for non-payment between 7-14 days; A further £40 for non-payment between 15-28 days

If any amount is outstanding, after a 28-day period, the accounts will attract interest on the overdue amount at 8% above bank base-rate, and as set out in our parent contract.

Other Charges

Extras fall into three broad categories; educational, recreational, and personal which are listed below.

Educational Charges

iPads

As part of the school's digital strategy, all pupils in Years 7 and 8 are issued with an iPad. All parents will be expected to complete the School's Parent iPad agreement and a charge of £80.00 per term will appear on the pupil's bill. This charge also includes Apple care insurance. Please note that this cover does not include any protection against loss or non-accidental damage.

School Trips

There will be opportunities to attend extra-curricular trips either within the UK or abroad. These will be at an extra cost.

Music Tuition

Individual music tuition is billed by the school in arrears, apart from guitar and drum lessons which are billed directly by the music teacher. The prices below are per term, per instrument (for up to 30 lessons per year).

Half a term's notice is required to discontinue an extra, or a half term's fee will be charged in lieu. Notice must be given, in writing, to the Finance Department and the teacher concerned.

Personal expenditure

Pupils and parents may incur additional charges for personal expenses. These include items from the School Shop (sports kit, equipment, and stationery), transport fees (for exeat and term start/end), day trips, theatre tickets, house parties, school photographs, dry cleaning, damage charges, private medical treatment, and transport for hospital visits.

Insurance

Endsleigh Pupils' £600k Personal Accident Insurance - included within the school fee is personal accident cover; pupils are automatically insured. Details will be sent out separately.

Endsleigh Pupils' Personal Effects Insurance

The school regrets that it is unable to accept responsibility for loss, damage, or theft of pupils' belongings. Parents can cover their child's property on an "All Risks" basis for up to £2,000 for a single item and £5,000 total sum insured. Your child will not be included in the scheme unless you elect to opt-in. Details will be sent out separately.

Endsleigh Pupil Absence Insurance

Fees and any agreed supplemental charges will not normally be reduced or refunded because of absence due to illness or otherwise.

Parents may be able to receive a refund of fees if their child is absent from school by paying an additional sum each term. Your child will not be included in the scheme unless you elect to opt-in. Notice Period

Please refer to the Terms and Conditions for more information but parents are reminded that a full term's notice is required when withdrawing a pupil. This should be made in writing to the Head's office. For example, to give notice for September 2026 the Headmaster needs to receive notice before the start of the Summer 2026 Term 20 April 2026.

VAT

HMRC introduced VAT from the 1st January 2025 on various educational supplies. The school will apply VAT where required and at the rates determined by HMRC. We will endeavour to show whether fees are inclusive or plus VAT, but the school must always charge within the HMRC statutory guidance and therefore rates may vary.
