



Your School Fees Explained 2026/27

Registration Fee

To register your child at Bryanston, a **non-refundable registration fee of £300** is required for pupils applying to **Years 9–12**.

Acceptance Deposit

Following a successful application, an **Acceptance Deposit** must be paid when submitting the completed and signed **Acceptance Form**.

If a pupil withdraws or does not take up their accepted place, this deposit is **non-refundable**.

- **UK-resident parents:**

An **Acceptance Deposit of £2,200** is required.

- **£1,000** will be credited towards the pupil's **first term's fees**.
- The remaining **£1,200** will be credited to the **final leaver's bill** at the end of the pupil's final **Summer Term**.

- **Parent resident outside the UK:**

In addition to the **£2,200 Acceptance Deposit**, a **One Term Fee Deposit** is required. This amount will be **credited to the final Summer Term fee bill**.

School Fees 2026/27 – Senior School

School fees are payable **seven days before the start of each term** by **Direct Debit or bank transfer**.

Fee bills will be made available on the **Parent Portal**, and an email notification will be sent from the **Chief Finance and Operations Officer** or a member of the Finance Team when they are ready to view.

Boarding fees for **2026/27** include:

- Tuition for the standard curriculum
- School facilities
- Travel for most sports and games
- Personal accident insurance
- Meals and accommodation
- Laundry services

An additional charge applies for **Day with Bed pupils who stay overnight**.

Please note that **breakfast and evening meals are not available for Day Only pupils**.

School fees are **reviewed periodically by the Governors** and may increase during your child's time at the school in accordance with the **School's Terms and Conditions**, which are available on our website.

Fee Notes

Day with Bed Pupils

Day with Bed pupils are fully integrated into **boarding house life**. Each pupil is allocated a bed within their house, allowing them to **flexi-board or transition to full boarding** if desired.

Pupils are welcome to stay overnight when required. However, parents must **inform the House Parent in advance**, and an **additional charge of £74.53 per night** will apply.

Day Pupils

Day pupils typically **arrive at 8:15am and depart at 6:00pm**. The **Day Service Bus leaves at 6:30pm** when the school day finishes.

Day pupils are assigned to a **boarding house** and participate fully in the **daily life of the school alongside their peers**.

Fees in Advance Scheme

Bryanston offers a **Fees in Advance Scheme**, which provides a **discount for parents who pay fees in advance as a lump sum**.

Parents should ensure **all bank charges are borne by you**, so the school receives the **full amount due**.

Changes to Bryanston's bank details will **only be communicated by the Chief Finance and Operations Officer**.

Late Payment of Fees

Late payment charges will apply as follows:

- **£40** per invoice for payments **7–14 days overdue**
- **An additional £40** for payments **15–28 days overdue**

If payment remains outstanding **after 28 days**, interest will be charged on the overdue balance at **5% above the Bank of England base rate**, in accordance with the **Parent Contract**.

Overseas Pupils

Pupils who require a **Child Student Visa** will be charged a **£600 compliance fee**.

Additional Charges (Extras)

Extras generally fall into three categories:

- **Educational**
- **Recreational**
- **Personal**

Educational Charges

iPads

As part of Bryanston's **digital learning strategy**, all pupils are issued with an **iPad, keyboard, cover, and stylus**.

Parents must complete the **Parent iPad Agreement**, and a charge of **£100 per term** will be added to the pupil's bill.

This charge includes **AppleCare insurance**, although it **does not cover loss or non-accidental damage**.

Materials used in **Art, Sculpture, Pottery, and Design & Technology** are also **charged termly in arrears**.

School Trips

Optional **co-curricular trips**, both within the UK and internationally, may be offered during the year and will be **charged separately**.

Music Tuition

Individual music lessons are charged **termly in arrears**.

- **£397.50 per term per instrument**
- **Up to 30 lessons per year**

Pupils are also responsible for the **cost of sheet music**.

A **half-term's notice** is required if a pupil wishes to discontinue lessons. Instrument hire is available for an **additional fee**.

Textbooks

Pupils purchase their own **textbooks and stationery**.

When textbooks are no longer required, they may be returned to the **School Shop**, which may repurchase them at **up to 50% of the original price**, provided they:

- Are unmarked
- Have undamaged covers
- Remain relevant to the curriculum

At the end of the first term, parents may also see **School Shop charges** for essential items such as:

- Laundry bags
- Name tapes
- Pens and stationery
- Calculators

- Paper pads
- Geometry sets

If you have already provided your child with any of these items then please ask them to take the unused item back to the School Shop to be credited to your account.

Individual Tuition and Learning Support

Where additional support is agreed with parents, **individual tuition** may be provided and charged as an extra.

One-to-one lessons (30 minutes): £56.60

Group lessons are charged at reduced rates:

Pupils	Cost per lesson
2 pupils	£34.60
3 pupils	£25.15

Subjects may include:

- English as an Additional Language (EAL)
- Mathematics Support
- Learning Support

Examination Fees

External examination fees are **charged separately**.

Special examination arrangements may incur **additional charges**.

Recreational Extras

Pupils can join a variety of **clubs, societies, and activities**, many of which carry additional charges.

Examples include:

- **Rowing:** £75.00 – £125.00 per term depending on squad level
- **Kayaking:** £59.50 per term

- **Sailing:** £36.00 per term (2026/27 prices TBC)
- **Squash:** £27.00 per session
- **Dance:** £8.40 per session
- **Speech and Drama:** £397.50 per term
- **Duke of Edinburgh:** registration and expedition costs
- **Equestrian:** £525 for ten lessons per term, if pupil is carrying out riding as a sport.
- **Horse livery:** £285 per horse per week

Private tuition for sports such as **tennis** may also be arranged.

Personal Expenditure

Additional personal expenses may include:

- School Shop purchases (uniform, sports kit, stationery)
- Transport at the start and end of term or for exeats
- Theatre tickets and social events
- School photographs
- Dry cleaning
- Damage charges
- Private medical treatment
- Transport for hospital visits

Membership fees for the **Bryanston Parents' Association** and **Beyond Bryanston (Alumni Association)** may also appear on bills. These are **optional and can be opted out of**.

Bryanston operates a **cashless campus**, so pupils require a **debit card, prepaid card, or digital payment method such as Apple Pay**.

Insurance

Personal Accident Insurance

The school fee includes **£600,000 personal accident insurance** through **Endsleigh**. All pupils are **automatically covered**.

Further details will be provided separately.

Personal Effects Insurance

The school cannot accept responsibility for **loss, damage, or theft of pupils' belongings**.

Parents may opt into an **"All Risks" insurance policy** covering:

- Up to **£2,000 per single item**
- Up to **£5,000 total**

This cover is **optional and requires enrolment**.

Pupil Absence Insurance

School fees are **not normally reduced or refunded due to absence**, including illness.

Parents may choose to register for **The Pupil Absence scheme**, which may provide reimbursement if a pupil is absent from school.

Further details will be sent separately.

Notice Period

A **full term's written notice** is required if a pupil is to be withdrawn from the school.

Notice must be submitted **in writing to the Head's Office**.

Example:

To withdraw a pupil for **September 2027**, notice must be received **before the start of the Summer Term 2027 (18 April 2027)**.

Please refer to the **School's Terms and Conditions** for full details.

VAT

From **1 January 2025**, HMRC introduced **VAT on certain educational supplies**.

Bryanston will apply VAT **where required**, in accordance with **HMRC regulations**.

Where possible, fee information will indicate whether prices are **inclusive of VAT or subject to VAT**.
